4th SUNDAY IN EASTER

Good Shepherd Sunday

First Reading: Acts 13: 14, 43-52
Responsorial: 100
Second Reading: Rev. 7: 9, 14b-17
Gospel John 10: 27-30



KEY VERSES: “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.”
John 10: 27

READINGS: The first reading presents an example how St. Paul exercised his ministry throughout Asia Minor and Greece. We hear of his successes and failures as he preached Christ crucified. He considered it a privilege given to him from God to suffer for the faith. Again, we see a vision of heaven in our second reading. The numbers going to heaven is numberless because they have been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. The Gospel is a short passage from Jesus’ proclamation that He is the Good Shepherd. He does not claim this on His own authority but rather because the Father has appointed Him to this role. The will of the Father is to reveal to us how much God loves us.

REFLECTING: This is traditionally known as “Good Shepherd” Sunday and is part of the continuing journey of Easter - remember that Jesus is the Good Shepherd who both gives his life for his sheep and takes it up again. His relationship with us, after the resurrection, is closer than we can imagine through his dying and rising, Jesus fulfils the promise he makes in today’s Gospel: “I give them eternal life, and they will never be lost.” This Sunday is another opportunity for us to consider the consequences of the Resurrection - how we live the Easter Story.

PRAYING: Heavenly Father, the Easter messages given to me through Holy Mass is to make me realize that life continues beyond the grave, May I always remember this great love offered by You through Your Son, the Risen Christ.
